ORDINANCE No. 1727

ORDINANCE VACATING STREET IN THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS, OTTAWA COUNTY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: The Governing Body of the City of Minneapolis orders the vacation of the following described property, to-wit:

The South five (5) feet of Second Street as it abuts to Lot One (1) of Block Four (4) of Isreal Markley's Second Addition more precisely described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot One (1) Block Four (4) of Isreal Markley's Second Addition, then proceeding 86 feet to the East, then five (5) feet to the North, then 86 feet to the West, then five (5) feet to the South to the point of beginning, in Minneapolis, Ottawa County, Kansas.

SECTION 2: This vacation reserves to the City and public utilities such right-of-way and easement as in the judgement of the governing body of the City, are necessary or desirable for public service in accordance with K.S.A. 12-512a.

SECTION 3: The City Clerk shall file a copy of this ordinance, duly certified as a true and correct copy, in the office of the Ottawa County Clerk and in the office of the Ottawa County Register of Deeds as provided in K.S.A. 14-423.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force for thirty (30) days after the publication thereof unless one or more interested parties file a written protest before the expiration of such time.
