ORDINANCE NO 1731

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR CONSUMPTION IN PUBLIC PLACES FORBIDDEN, BEING SECTION 3-206 AND 3-206a OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS, OTTAWA COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Minneapolis established the alcoholic liquor consumption in public places forbidden requirements through the passage of ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds it in the best interest of the City to repeal the alcoholic liquor consumption in public places forbidden requirements and proceed with enforcement of other applicable code sections.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: The Governing Body of the City of Minneapolis hereby repeals in its entirety Chapter 3, Article 2, Section 206 and Section 206a - **Alcoholic liquor consumption in public places forbidden**.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its publication in the official newspaper of said city.
