ORDINANCE NO: 1732

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VIII OF THE MINNEAPOLIS CODE OF 2016, PERTAINING TO NUISANCES AND THE STORAGE OF INOPERABLE VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS, KANSAS, AND AMENDING OR REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: The Minneapolis Code of 2016 shall be amended as follows:

8-903 NUISANCES UNLAWFUL

- (b) The provisions of this article shall not apply to:
 - (1) Any motor vehicle which is enclosed in a garage or other building;
 - (2) The parking or storage of a vehicle inoperable for a period of 30 consecutive days or less: or
 - (3) Any person conducting a business enterprise in compliance with existing zoning regulations or who places such vehicles behind screening of sufficient size, strength and density to screen such vehicles from the view of the public and to prohibit ready access to stored vehicles by children. However, nothing in this subsection shall be construed to authorize the maintenance of a public nuisance.

SECTION 2: The existing section of 8-903 of the Minneapolis Code of 2016 is hereby amended.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be effective November 12th, 2024, and be in force from this day.
